

Operation Where's the Beef – Donation Drop Off

Last week, due to a large donation of meat from the Pilgrim meat company, our church in conjunction with the local non-profit Serve 6.8, hosted and participated in a chicken meal distribution which resulted in serving over **350 families** in need in the Windsor and Greeley areas. This inspired the donation of 1000 pounds of beef arriving next week, and Serve 6.8 asked us to participate in another meal distribution.

As we provide beef to these families, we would also like to send them home with a full bag of sides to go with it. We did this with the chicken meals, and it was such a blessing! However, we currently don't have these sides as we gave away ALL our food!

If you are feeling led and able to participate in helping fill those bags, please consider bringing some of these items and dropping them in the designated box at my front door:

- Buns/rolls
- Fruits and vegetables
- Other easy to make sides, instant rice, pasta, etc.
- Non-perishable desserts
- Grocery bags
